

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF WORLAND, WYOMING  
May 21, 2007

A regular meeting of the City Council of Worland, Wyoming convened in the Council Chambers in City Hall at 7:00 p.m. on May 21, 2007. Mayor Sonny Shearer presided and the Councilmembers in attendance were: Bud Callaham, Loyd Worley, Jerry Alexander, Justin Pfeiffer, Shane Anderson, Vasca Gilmore, George Hazen, Bob Nelsen and Curt Christoffersen. Also present were: City Attorney, Kent Richins; Police Chief, Bob Richardson and Clerk-Treasurer, Tracy Glanz.

There were sixteen visitors present for this meeting of the City Council.

Jeff Taylor led the Council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion: to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on May 7, 2007.

By: Councilmember Hazen.

Second by: Councilmember Callaham.

Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

Motion: to approve the payroll for the period ending May 6, 2007; PAYROLL – 5/6/07 - \$56,391.50.

By: Councilmember Hazen.

Second by: Councilmember Callaham.

Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

Motion: to allow the Town of Ten Sleep to use the street sweeper two times a year if the Town pays all expenses, including fuel, labor and replacement of brooms if necessary.

By: Councilmember Nelsen.

Second by: Councilmember Callaham.

Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Shearer inquired about interest in the WDA board appointment. Discussion followed; the appointment was tabled.

Motion: to lease/purchase two (2) gators from Lathrop Equipment with the stipulation that nothing else can be purchased without approval from the Council.

By: Councilmember Hazen.

Second by: Councilmember Callaham.

Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

Motion: to ratify and approve the actions of the boards and commissions of the Worland City Council.

By: Councilmember Hazen.

Second by: Councilmember Worley.

Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

Motion: to put a freeze on hiring full-time employees without prior approval of the Council.

By: Councilmember Worley.

Second by: Councilmember Christoffersen.

Vote: Councilmembers voting AYE: Anderson, Nelsen, Pfeiffer, Christoffersen, Worley, Callaham, Alexander and Gilmore. Councilmember voting NAY: Hazen. The motion passed by a vote of 8 to 1.

The Council directed City Attorney Kent Richins to seek appraisals on properties owned by the City, specifically 1216 Charles and the Community Hall property.

The being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
