

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF WORLAND, WYOMING

July 16, 2007

A regular meeting of the City Council of Worland, Wyoming convened in the Council Chambers in City Hall at 7:00 p.m. on July 16, 2007. Mayor Sonny Shearer presided and the Councilmembers in attendance were: Jerry Alexander, Loyd Worley, Bud Callaham, Curt Christoffersen and Bob Nelsen. Also present were: City Attorney, Kent Richins; Superintendent of Public Works, Gene Cliame and Clerk-Treasurer, Tracy Glanz. Councilmembers Vasca Gilmore, Justin Pfeiffer, Shane Anderson and George Hazen were absent.

Motion: to allow Airport Manager, Gary Thompson to award the bid for the Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Vehicle (ARFF).

City Attorney Kent Richins presented Ordinance No. 767 for second reading: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WORLAND, WASHAKIE COUNTY, WYOMING, ESTABLISHING AND AMENDING REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO INDUSTRIAL PRETREATMENT BY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING PORTIONS OF ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 23 OF THE WORLAND CITY CODE. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

Motion: to ratify and approve the actions of the boards and commissions of the Worland City Council.

Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

Motion: to approve sending three (3) employees to Mueller Product Training School in Casper on August 3, 2007.
By: Councilmember Nelsen.
Second by: Councilmember Alexander.
Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

Motion: this Council states that the longevity bonus will not be paid next budget cycle.
By: Councilmember Christoffersen.

Mayor Shearer asked the Council to wait to vote on the motion until there was a full Council in attendance.

The motion died for lack of a second.

The Clerk/Treasurer was advised by the Council to discard any unsigned correspondence sent to the Mayor/Council. This includes letters regarding the Worland Shooting Complex.
