

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF WORLAND, WYOMING
December 3, 2007

On the 3rd day of December, 2007 the City Council of Worland, Wyoming met in regular session in the Council Chambers in City Hall at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Sonny Shearer presided and the Councilmembers in attendance were: Bud Callaham, Loyd Worley, Jerry Alexander, Bob Nelsen, Vasca Gilmore, George Hazen, Justin Pfeiffer, Shane Anderson and Curt Christoffersen. Also present were: City Attorney, Kent Richins; Police Chief, Bob Richardson, Capt. Andy Williams, Sgt. Tom Brase and Clerk-Treasurer, Tracy Glanz.

There were four visitors present for this meeting of the City Council.

Sgt. Tom Brase led the Council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion: to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on November 19, 2007 and the work session on November 26, 2007.

Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

Motion: to approve the November bills and the payrolls for the periods ending November 18, 2007 and November 30, 2007; PAYROLL – 11/18/07 - \$51,203.95; PAYROLL – 11/30/07 - \$3,848.78.

Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

City Attorney Kent Richins reviewed with the Mayor and Council the proposed Green Hills Golf Course Management Agreement. Mike Greear, Dave Bostrom and Charles Gilmore representing the Green Hills Golf Club were present to answer any questions.

Motion: to approve and authorize the Mayor to sign the Green Hills Golf Course Management Agreement with Green Hills Golf Club.

Vote: Councilmembers voting AYE: Anderson, Pfeiffer, Christoffersen, Worley, Callaham, Alexander, Hazen and Gilmore; Councilmembers voting NAY: None; Councilmembers ABSTAINING: Nelsen. The motion passed.
