

Work Session of the City Council  
of Worland Wyoming  
March 24, 2008

A work session for the City Council of Worland, Wyoming convened in the Council Chambers in City Hall at 7:02 p.m. on March 24, 2008. The Councilmembers in attendance were: Loyd Worley, Bud Callaham, George Hazen, Bob Nelsen, Vasca Gilmore and Curt Christoffersen. Also present were Clerk/Treasurer Tracy Glanz, Josh Weickum with Josh's Custom Computers & Repair and Mike Karr with the Northern Wyoming Daily News.

The following items were discussed:

- Video Cameras
- WAM Survey
- Budget
- Community Development Vehicle
- City Hall Lunch Hour

Discussion on **Video Cameras**:

- Presentation by Josh Weickum of Josh's Custom Computers & Repair.
- Visual presentation of the camera view.
- Can have 16 cameras per server.
- Server would be placed at dispatch.
- 2 cameras initially to be placed at Pioneer Square and Sanders Park.
- Cameras span & tilt; approximate cost \$1,001 per camera.
- Other costs including housing, power adaptors, router, server hard drive and software.
- Total estimated cost \$14,755.40 for equipment & set-up of 2 cameras.
- Total estimated annual cost (service agreement & ISP service) \$5,400.
- Josh may be willing to be paid at an hourly rate of \$45.00/Hr. instead of requiring a service agreement for the first year.
- Could install cameras and equipment right away.
- City of Rawlins uses this service.
- What has City spent on vandalism?
- Homeland Security Grant may pay for this.
- Need to look at budget.

Discussion on **WAM Survey**:

- Those in attendance completed the survey.

Discussion on **Budget**:

- Revenue vs. Expense worksheet.
- Need % of department budgets vs. total budget for 5 years.
- Discussion on wages.
- Council members should all attend budget meetings.

Discussion on **Community Development Vehicle:**

- Put truck back into service, use car at City Hall.
- Clerk/Treasurer will check into it.

Discussion on **City Hall Lunch Hour:**

- Council asked to consider closing City Hall during the lunch hour for security reasons.
- Will have more traffic when municipal court clerk is at City Hall.
