

Utilities/Enterprise Commission  
June 11, 2007

The Commission of Utilities/Enterprise met in regular session at Worland City Hall at 5:30 p.m. Commission members present were Bud Callaham and Loyd Worley. Also attending were City Engineer Mike Donnell, Superintendent of Public Works Gene Clame, Assistant Superintendent of Public Works Gary Gerber, Deputy Clerk Linda Frisbee and Jileana Childs of the Northern Wyoming Daily News. Visitors attending were Laura Linneman and Clay Gibbons. Commission member Bob Nelsen was absent.

Laura Linneman approached the Commission about installing individual water meters to the trailers that she purchased from Clint Carneal on North 15<sup>th</sup> Street. There are nine trailer lots that are on one water meter. Gary explained to Laura the procedure for installing the individual meters to the trailers.

Clay Gibbons presented to the Commission a preliminary map of the Gibbons Subdivision for subdividing the nine acres of the property that he has for sale. The Worland Fire Department is buying the back lot.

City Engineer Mike Donnell informed the Commission about the State Transportation Improvement Program meeting with WYDOT about their projects that are coming up. Mike also informed the Commission about the Bomber Peak storm sewer system. According to Stan the only place that it can be connected to is the Sunrise Heights pvc pipe that flows into the canal. They will need to check with the canal company. They will also need to update the manholes to meet the public works specs. Mike also discussed the testing that has to be done on the new streets and alleys. Mike discussed Wal-Mart and the proposed 36<sup>th</sup> street not being wide enough for three lanes to meet the standards. There was discussion about the sewer line out to the Airport and the Lane 14 residents. The property owners want the sewer line in the north traffic lane of the road.

Assistant Superintendent of Public Works Gary Gerber informed the Commission that the crew is busy doing some crack sealing.

Superintendent of Public Works Gene Clame informed the Commission that he is going to see if the contractor that is doing the paving for the subdivisions will do Road 11 and 14<sup>th</sup> Street, and some other repairs. Gene will have the crew prep the streets ahead of the contractor.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned. The next Utilities/Enterprise Commission will be July 9, 2007 at 5:30 p.m.
